when you get here...

- There is a shuttle if you need assistance to the door - call 812-523-7447
- We have you registered, so you will not need to register when you arrive.
- Please come to the MAIN ENTRANCE near the Emergency Room and tell a greeter you are here. If no one is there, go to Registration desk and have them call Respiratory Therapy.
- Someone will come to the main lobby to get you.
- You will be asked to ride to the department in a wheelchair. This is standard procedure and done for the safety of all patients.

how to prepare for the EEG?

THIS TEST TAKES APPROXIMATELY 2 HOURS TO COMPLETE

The night or day before the test

- Do whatever you can to come to us sleep-deprived, with no more than 4 hours of sleep (*request of the physician who will be interpreting your test*)
- Do not take any naps,
- Do not use caffeine,
- Do not have any alcohol,
- Please have your hair freshly brushed, clean and free of gels, and sprays.
- Please do not wear earrings.
- You may eat meals and snacks as normal, there are no restrictions except the ones listed above.
