### ER

**With the following types of injuries, your employee should be evaluated in the Emergency Department:**

- ✓ Complex lacerations, including lacerations involving the eyelids, nose, or ears
- ✓ Obvious fractures with bones visibly angulated or protruding through the skin
- ✓ Falls from greater than 4 feet, if the worker suffered a head injury
- ✓ Spinal (neck to tailbone) trauma with new or worsening numbness and tingling in the arms or legs
- ✓ Eye injuries involving significant trauma or embedded foreign bodies
- ✓ Chemical exposure causing shortness of breath or chest pain
- ✓ Major trauma such as motor vehicle accidents, penetrating objects, significant crush injuries, or significant blunt trauma
- ✓ Severe burns on the palms of the hands, soles of the feet, respiratory tract, groin, or large surface area burns
